This week, to celebrate **EARTH DAY**, we are going to create simple folded paper birds!

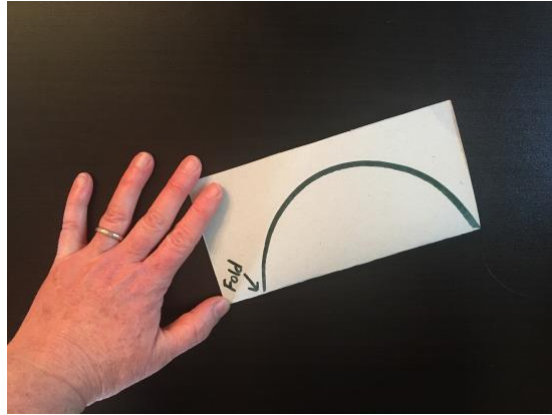
Materials:

- Small recycled paper, cardstock or thin cardboard
- Scissors
- Pencil, markers, crayons, colored pencils, or whatever you have to color

Step 1: Fold your recycled paper in half one time.



Step 2: Make sure your fold is at the bottom (close to your belly button) and draw an arched line (like a rainbow).



Step 2: Cut out along the line. Turn it so it is an upside-down taco.



Step 3: Draw bird details, I like to start with one pointy end as the beak. You might have your own way to draw bird details.



Step 4: Color neatly to make an imaginary bird or a real bird.



I made a cardinal!



They will stand up on their own and balance on branches, just like ME!
